

Bonnie has worked on more than 40 short films, many of which have screened at international and Australian film festivals. In 2006 she won three Australian Cinematographers Society (ACS) awards, including a Gold for Vend, a Young Filmmakers Fund short that won Best Film at the 2006 St Kilda Film Festival and was nominated for an IF award. At the 2007 ACS Awards she received a Gold for Frail (an official selection of the 2007 Palm Springs International Film Festival), and a Bronze for feeling-lonely? (a finalist at the 2007 Manhattan Short Film Festival). She has a Masters in Cinematography from the Australian Film Television and Radio School and during her time there directed her first film as a solo writer /director - Meditations on a Name - which screened at the 2007 Sydney Film Festival, and in competition at the 2008 Berlin International Film Festival. She won the Rising Talent Award at the 2007 IF Awards.
